- Archery range status:

 - Targets are \$90 plus shipping.
 - They come with a lifetime guarantee.
 - They are 24" x 24".
 - Each is about 40 pounds.
 - Considering a 100 yard range with different shooting points.
 - Pat McCoy moved that we allow \$750 to purchase targets. Second by Tim Allen. Vote taken. Motion passed.
