- LOCATION: Meagher County Sportsmen's Association outdoor range located 2 miles N of WSS on Jackson Rd.
- TIME: Firing begins at 10:00 am prompt
- REGISTRATION: Registration will be accepted until the first relay has been called for the first match.

- EQUIPMENT: Any .22 rimfire rifle weighing 8.5# or less. Iron sights and any sight classes.
- RULES NRA BP rifle rule 3.13(a) for cross-sticks, and eye and ear protection is required. Open Chamber Indicator required (available at range for .50).
- COURSE OF FIRE: All firing will be done at metallic gongs. Five shots at each of six Targets of various size and shape from 70 to 160 yards. With nearest shot offhand, all other sitting with cross-sticks.
- AWARDS: Fame and Glory.
- CLASSIFICATION: This is an Open match. No classification will be used.

**NRA BP rifle rule 3.13(a)**

Crossed Sticks: Crossed sticks constructed of two wooden legs, no greater than 1 inch by 2 inches in thickness and width or 1-1/2 inches in diameter, and bolted or tied so that the two legs are hinged and capable of pivoting. The end of the legs may be equipped with spikes no more than 3 inches in length and no wider than the edge of the crossed stick. They may be inserted into the ground by hand pressure only to aid in retention of an upright position. This may be waived by the Match Director to fit local conditions. One layer of protective material may be suspended or inserted in the "V" of the crossed sticks to protect the rifle. All cross sticks will be certified.
