Correspondence:

- The Meagher County Chamber of Commerce about renewing/becoming a member. Discussion ensued on if we should pay the \$100 for membership or not. Majority felt that we should not at this time. No motion was taken and the matter was tabled.
- Pat McCoy had submitted an email listing possible activities for the club this year. Items included: Intro to Shooting (Women Only), a weekly/bi-weekly pistol shoot, winter indoor small bore shoot, club yard sale/gun show, long range clinic (700-900 yds.), hunting clinic (400-600 yds.), public "Intro to Shooting Day" with different types of firearms, small-bore silhouette shoot, and a 300+ yd. small-bore gong match.

Committee Reports:

- The Secretary will send out an email invite to all members to help form a Range Committee and a Shooting Committee.

Unfinished Business:

- NRA, CMP, USAS, MT R&P, MRPA, memberships renewed
- Status on blinds for indoor range windows – Windows are not a standard size and Pat McCoy is looking into stores like Home Depot where they can be cut to size.
- Gary Smith reported that all targets are in adequate supply
- Mike Greener reported no progress on range camera. Weather not much help.
- Dates for the 2019 calendar are coming together and will be posted in the Community Calendar section of the newspaper. Event results will also be in the paper along with reminders for upcoming events.
- The meeting for the Board of Directors on March 5th was cancelled and rescheduled for March 28th at 7pm at the clubhouse.
- Handover of the website to the new Webmaster has been fraught with difficulty so the minutes for the March meeting will be emailed to all members.

New Business:

- Tim Allen had to plow the road into the range twice this winter. Lots of snow and drifts. The road is now open but you may want some snowshoes to go out and place targets on the range.
- Tim Allen submitted a bid to the club for a spring re-do of the road to the range. He explained that when he plowed the snow this winter there is so little gravel in places the culverts on the road were exposed to road wear. The project would likely require 4 to 5 dump trucks of gravel, blade work, and compacting. The project would start sometime in May and cost close to \$2,000. After much discussion, Bill Cummins moved that the club pay for the cost out of our operations account, Pat McCoy 2nd, motion passed.
- Planning for upcoming events has proceeded nicely with gun classes scheduled for April, Clean Up Day on June 1st, Turkey Shoot/Open House on June 2nd. Bench rest shoots in June, and Steel Target Challenges every other week starting June 13th.
